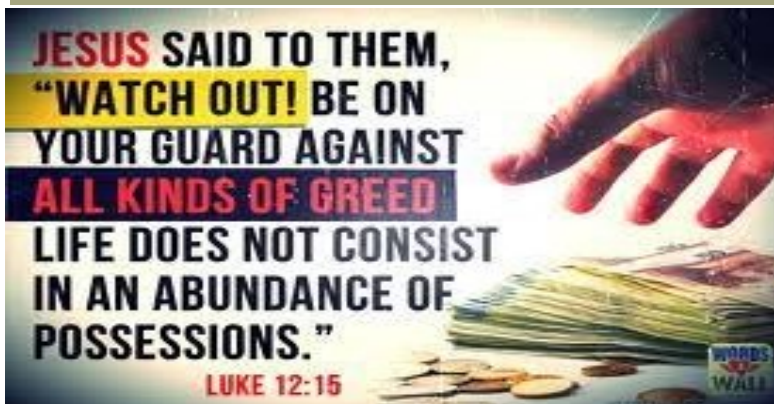

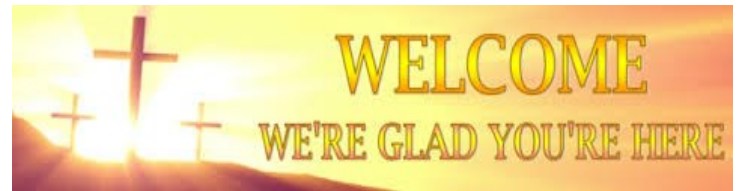

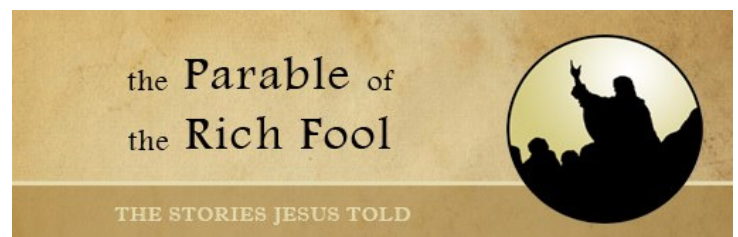


From the Administrator's Desk

THE ONLY ESSENTIAL

This week while we are mourning the death of one of the most wonderful priests who ministered at Saint Angela's, Father John Leopold Morin O.M.I., we are also holding our yearly Jericho mission. This event happens once every year on the last week of July at our Blue Hill Ave Parish. It is a seven-day devotional structured around praise, adoration, intercession, and thanksgiving to the Lord. The Jericho Mission is a spiritual space where many gather to look for God and for everything. People from Saint Angela's and from the different Haitian communities who gathered there are people who pray and dance, cry and laugh at the same time. For, we are people in need, who pray for help, for healing, for strength, and for a better life. God at times becomes a God of consumption for our needs. In this weekend's gospel Jesus warns his disciples to beware of all greed and disordered desires for possessions. He states that a person's life does not consist in the abundance of one's possessions. Jesus warns us not to be anxious about riches and idols of this world. We are also called this weekend to re-hear the cry of King Solomon after having possessed all riches and honors: "Vanity of vanities, all is vanity." To Solomon the most precious treasure to look and to ask for in prayer was to have a heart set on God, what he called wisdom. May our prayers and requests this weekend and all our spiritual life be oriented toward the good of goods, the source of infinite happiness, 'the better part, Jesus would say,' and the true treasure of the Kingdom. For, everything passes, only God is forever. May the Lord our God be the 'Only Essential' we need!

Chers Amis, en cette période de vacances d'été, les textes liturgiques nous proposent de réfléchir sur les biens matériels. Oui, bien sûr, nous en avons besoin pour assurer notre quotidien. Mais le vrai problème est ailleurs: on se donne beaucoup de peine pour accumuler les richesses, ont fait preuve d'ingéniosité, on s'impose des fatigues qui ruinent la santé, l'union des foyers, l'éducation des enfants. Le confort matériel c'est bien, mais si notre vie n'est pas remplie d'amour, il manque l'essentiel. Dans une de ses homélies, le pape François nous dit que la cupidité est une idolâtrie. Il recommande de la combattre avec la capacité de partager, de donner et de se donner aux autres. Un homme vient demander à Jésus de se faire l'arbitre dans ses problèmes d'héritage. Jésus refuse d'être juge dans cette affaire. Il en profite pour dire qu'il y a des richesses que nous n'emporterons pas au paradis. Pour mieux se faire comprendre, l'évangile de ce dimanche nous parle d'un homme riche matériellement. Ce que Jésus dénonce dans cette histoire, ce n'est pas les richesses mais l'attachement aux richesses. Ailleurs, il nous dit qu'il est très difficile à un homme attaché aux richesses d'entrer dans le Royaume des cieux. Le pape François précise que cette attachement immodéré aux richesses est une idolâtrie. En ce dix-huitième dimanche de l'année C, nous sommes donc tous invités à édifier le monde des hommes non sur la fortune de quelques-uns mais sur la justice qu'inspire l'amour. Alors plus que jamais, nous accueillons cet appel à la conversion: Aujourd'hui, ne fermons pas notre cœur mais écoutons la voix du Seigneur.

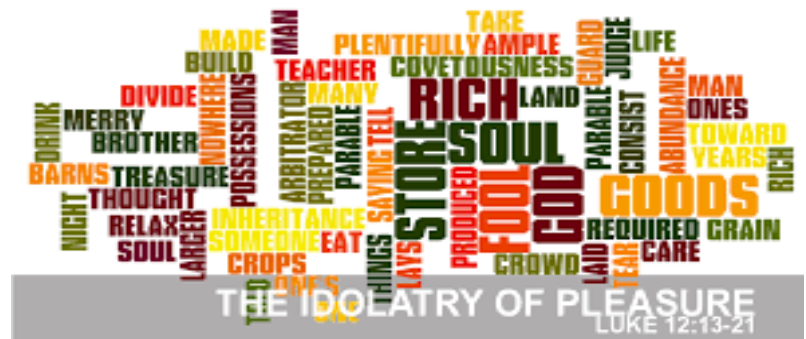

HISTORIQUE DU MOIS D'AOÛT? Le mois d'Août est le huitième mois du calendrier grégorien et julien. Son nom vient du latin Augustus, nom donné à ce mois en l'honneur de l'Empereur romain Auguste en 8 av. J.C.. Avant lui, dans l'ancien calendrier romain, Août était le sixième mois de l'année et portait le nom de Sextilis (de sextus, sixième). Cependant l'Empereur romain Auguste décida d'ajouter un jour de plus au mois d'Août, qui porte son nom, pour en avoir 31, soit autant que le mois de Juillet, qui lui était appelé ainsi en l'honneur de Jules César. Ce jour a été substitué au mois de Février, qui à l'époque était le dernier de l'année. Le mot « Août » se prononce [ut], ou bien dans certaines régions de la France, [u]. Il y a aussi deux autres prononciations, [a.u] et [a.ut] qui sont moins tolérées. Les deux graphies « Août » et « Aout » sont maintenant correctes, néanmoins le rapport de 1990 sur les rectifications orthographiques recommande l'utilisation de la graphie « Aout », sans accent circonflexe. Mais l'orthographe avec accent est prépondérante, et encore largement utilisée. Rappelons que le mois d'Août est le mois de l'Assomption et du Cœur Immaculé de Marie, qui est intimement uni au Sacré-Cœur du Christ présent dans l'Eucharistie.

Fr. John Morin OMI

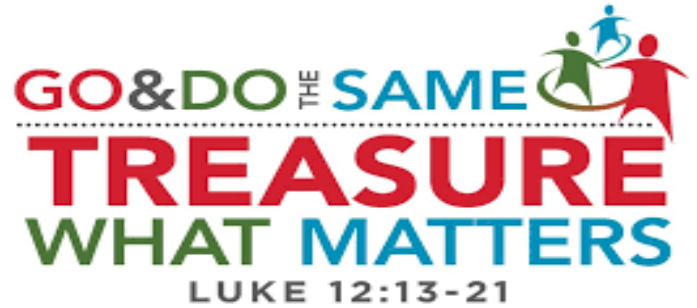
Dear Friends:

This past Sunday morning the Lord called home one of his great priests, Fr. John Morin, OMI. Fr. John and I worked and lived together at St. Angela's for many years. John was not only an outstanding priest and warm, caring human being he was also a wonderful person to live with. We had many challenging experiences together. There was the fire that closed our church for a year from October 1996-October 1997. Through it all Fr. John was positive and upbeat as he lead the Haitian community in Sunday worship at the school and daily Mass in the Rectory dining room. There was the joyous re-opening of the Church when Cardinal Law came and we processed from the school yard onto Blue Hill Avenue. We could not fit all the people into the Church so Cardinal Law had all the children come and sit on the floor of the altar. There were the sad wakes and funerals in which he helped so many people through the journey from death to new life. Our birthdays were within a week of each other in the beginning of July. This was always an occasion for big celebrations and festive meals in the Parish Hall.

Fr. John was the heart and soul of the Haitian community at St. Angela's for many years. He was a very talented priest but always humble and prayerful. We have all been blessed by God through Fr. John's presence in each of our lives. Let us thank God for Fr. John's ministry and example of being the Good Shepherd for all of us. He touched many, many lives as he showed all of us that indeed Jesus is the Way the Truth and the Life. I will offer Mass for him this weekend at the Cathedral in Galway, Ireland. May we all continue to pray for him and for one another.
