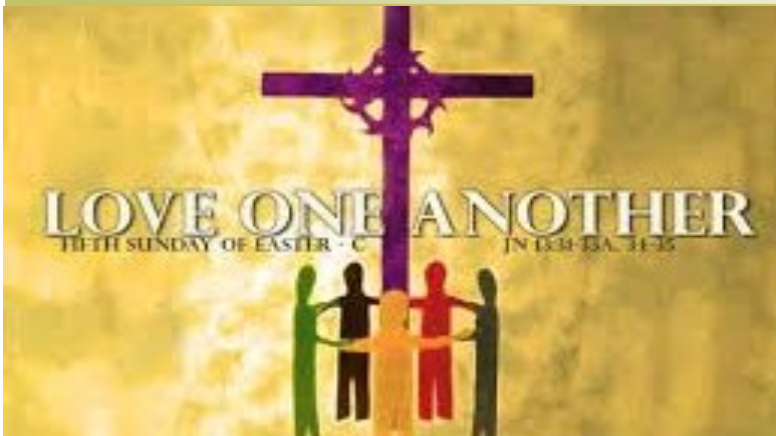

This weekend's gospel is very short. And yet it says it all. Jesus prepares his disciples for his departure. He points out what is truly essential to put into practice. "I give you a new commandment, love one another. This is how all will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another." Jesus' message about love is also one of the most demanding. For, Jesus didn't say: I give you an advice, love those who love you. That would be very easy, logic, and realistic! But Jesus said: "I give you a commandment: love one another... Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you." And that is a little more complicated! To Jesus, love is not just an advice; love is a commandment. Love is due not only to those who love us, or those who are close to us; love is due to everyone, even those who do not love us, even our enemies, even the wicked. Jesus calls each of us to witness his love and mercy to all. He not only calls us, but by his life and death he shows us how to do it. The Blessed John Henry Cardinal Newman had said: "We love because it is our nature to love, and it is our nature because God the Holy Spirit has made it our nature." During World War II as the world witnessed the greatest deployment of hate, violence and absurdity in history, a prisoner in the midst of such a tragedy wrote on the wall of a prison in Auschwitz: "I believe in God even when he is silent, I believe in the Sun even when it is not shining, I believe in Love even when I don't feel it." Love is the only word that can express who God is: As St John said: Whoever is without love does not know God, for God is love.

### AIMÉ COMME UN ÊTRE UNIQUE

Mes frères et Sœurs, en écoutant la lecture des Actes Apôtres, on pourrait penser que Paul et Barnabé sont des touristes heureux. Non, ce n'est pas du tourisme que cette visite des Églises, c'est une visite pastorale. Paul porte le souci de toutes les communautés chrétiennes qu'il a fondées lors de ses voyages missionnaires. Il revient les fortifier dans la foi, les encourager face aux persécutions, les organiser en leur donnant des « Anciens » pour les encadrer ( le mot « ancien » en grec se dit « presbytères » qui a donné le mot français « prêtre ». Et Paul prend soin de partager avec tous : « Ayant réuni tous les membres de l'Église... » Dans le psaume, toutes les œuvres divines sont invitées à rendre grâce à Dieu pour ce qu'il accomplit par les mains de ses serviteurs, ici, le travail de Paul et Barnabé. Quant au livre de l'Apocalypse (« apocalypse » ne veut pas dire « catastrophe »; il n'y a pas là de Bruce Willis ou d'Arnold Schwarzenegger, mais « révélation »), ce livre, donc, nous décrit la fin des temps ( et non la fin du monde, la Terre est renouvelée, et non détruite ) comme une transformation « voici la demeure de Dieu avec les hommes... il essuiera toute larme de leurs yeux ». Aimé comme un être unique dont il est question ici est le rayonnement de l'amour de Dieu qui va se manifester par l'acceptation par Jésus de sa tragique destinée. Voilà, cela fait preuve d'amour ! La nouveauté, ce n'est pas le commandement d'aimer, Jésus ne l'invente pas, le commandement d'amour existe bel et bien dans l'enseignement des rabbins de son temps. Ce qui est nouveau, c'est d'aimer vraiment comme lui, en étant guidé par son Esprit. Pour le dire autrement, Dieu sait si l'amour au jour le jour est difficile: c'est presque un miracle! Mais si nous y parvenons dans nos communautés chrétiennes, le monde sera bien obligé d'admettre cette évidence que l'Esprit du Christ agit en nous!

Paul and Barnabas tell the other disciples, "It is necessary for us to undergo many hardships to enter the kingdom of God." Even today, the Church experiences hardships. In today's Gospel Jesus gives a simple command but one that can be hard to lie by: "...I give you a new commandment: love one another. As I have loved you, so you also should love one another." Notice the catch in Jesus' words. He doesn't say love one another rather he says love as He loves. Imagine life in your family, in your parish and in our world if you took this command to heart. Yet that is the mark of a disciple!

### CONSECRATION DU MOIS DE MAI A MARIE :

Au XIIIème siècle déjà, le roi de Castille, Alphonse X le Sage, avait associé dans un de ses chants la beauté de Marie et celle du mois de mai. Au siècle suivant, le bienheureux dominicain Henri Suso avait, durant l'époque des fleurs, l'habitude de tresser des couronnes pour les offrir, au premier jour de mai, à la Vierge. En 1549, un bénédictin, Seidl, avait publié un livre intitulé "Le mois de mai spirituel", alors que saint Philippe Néri exhortait déjà les jeunes gens à manifester un culte particulier à Marie pendant le mois de mai où il réunissait les enfants autour de l'autel de la Sainte Vierge pour lui offrir les fleurs du printemps. Un peu plus tard, les jésuites recommandaient que, la veille du premier mai, dans chaque appartement, on dressât un autel à Marie, orné de fleurs et de lumières, autour duquel, chaque jour du mois, la famille se réunirait pour réciter quelques prières en l'honneur de la Sainte Vierge avant de tirer au sort un billet qui indiquerait la vertu à pratiquer le lendemain. Cette dévotion mariale s'est perpétuée jusqu'à nos jours.
