## From the Administrator's Desk

### ARE WE LIVING FOR DYING?

#### WELCOME TO OUR WEEKLY PARISH BULLETIN!

The celebrations of all saints and all souls went very smoothly in our two parishes. I was amazed to witness the great enthusiasm of our parishioners for praying for the repose of souls of their departed. November is the month of remembrance and prayers for the dead. It is also the last month in the liturgy calendar. For these reasons, most of its Scripture readings sound a bit harsh and apocalyptic. There's a story about a judge who was sentencing a prisoner to the death penalty. As the convict was hearing of the sentence he screamed out loud: "we are all condemned to death, and we all are awaiting our execution that will surely come." Victor Hugo, a famous French scholar, would have agreed with such a statement as he wrote a century before: "we are all condemned to death with an indefinite reprieve." These are strong reminders that all of us are passing through; we will die someday. But the question is still relevant: are we truly condemned to death? Are we living for dying? In this weekend's gospel, when the Sadducees tried to trap Jesus by evoking a complicated legal Jewish case, they unconsciously tackled the same question: what will happen to us after death? This question particularly relevant on this month of November has become a serious matter of study even among scientists. Despite all appearances, we proclaim that death is not the last appointment, nor the goal of our life. God has created us for life, not for death. Jesus came so that we may have life, life in its fullness. Actually, we don't know yet what the hereafter is made of; we only believe that it exists. At present we see vaguely, Saint Paul said, but in the eternity we will clearly see everything. In the meantime, "Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed."

Les trois lectures de ce Dimanche viennent nourrir notre foi et soutenir notre espérance. La controverse entre les Sadducéens et Jésus dans l'évangile nous montre pour sa part combien la foi en la résurrection n'était pas acquise et qu'elle faisait même l'objet de moqueries déplacées. Cette histoire des sept frères et de la veuve de l'aîné est suffisamment caricaturale pour que Jésus ne s'y arrête pas et rappelle seulement qu'on ne peut pas imaginer la vie éternelle à partir de celle-ci. Elle n'en est ni le prolongement ni le recommencement ! Elle en est l'accomplissement. Quand Jésus se montrera vivant à ses disciples au-delà de sa mort, il ne s'agira plus d'une discussion ou d'une théorie, il s'agira d'une expérience réelle de sa présence renouvelée et de l'accomplissement de la promesse du Père dans son amour fidèle. « Là où je vais, vous serez vous aussi ». Cela nous suffit ! Etre avec Celui qui habite nos cœurs nous suffit, nous comble et nous comblera.

Chers amis, voilà bien notre condition et notre mission aujourd'hui dans le monde ! Témoigner de notre foi en Christ Ressuscité par la manière même de vivre notre vie, nos épreuves, nos joies, nos engagements, les moments où la mort menace et frappe. Faisons-le de manière fidèle le Dimanche, ce jour où depuis plus de 2000 ans les Baptisés se rassemblent pour fêter le Christ, Soleil levant, Vainqueur du péché et de la mort, pour participer au repas du Ressuscité, signe de Celui que le Père prépare en son Royaume ! Maintenons vivante la mémoire du Seigneur ! Et ensuite, persévérons dans notre vie de croyants, nous qui proclamons inviolable la dignité de tout être humain appelé à vivre en Dieu et pour Dieu. Faisons le par notre attention privilégiée pour les plus abimés de la vie !

**LA DEDICACE DE LA BASILIQUE DU LATRAN:** Après la fête de "l'Église du ciel" en la Toussaint le 1er novembre et celle de "l'Église du purgatoire" le Jour des Morts le 2 novembre, c'est en quelque sorte la fête de "l'Église de la terre" que nous célébrons avec la dédicace de la Basilique Saint Jean de Latran le 9 novembre. Aux premiers siècles du christianisme, l'Église persécutée ne pouvait bâtir de temples, elle devait donc célébrer les divins mystères dans des maisons particulières ou dans les catacombes, sur les tombeaux des martyrs. Mais quand la paix fut donnée aux chrétiens, on vit bientôt surgir de toutes parts des temples magnifiques en l'honneur du seul vrai Dieu, sur les ruines des temples du paganisme. Le Christ et sa Croix rendirent l'empereur Constantin victorieux de son rival Maxence. Ne marchandant pas sa reconnaissance, le grand empereur mit fin aux persécutions sanglantes, donna la liberté à l'Église et fit construire sur l'emplacement du palais des Laterani la basilique du Saint-Sauveur, aussi appelée Basilique Saint Jean de Latran dont le pape saint Sylvestre fit la dédicace le 9 novembre 324. Cette fête mérite de notre part un respect tout particulier. Les édifices de nos églises nous montrent dans le temple la maison de prière, la maison de Dieu, une image de la Jérusalem céleste, la porte du Ciel. Même les pierres de nos églises nous parlent pour nous rappeler que nous sommes les pierres vivantes du Temple mystique que Dieu ne cesse de construire.
