### FAILING TO LOVE

#### WELCOME TO OUR WEEKLY PARISH BULLETIN!

The Patron feast of Saint Matthew truly was a great success. The Sunday solemn mass as well as the preparatory 'Triduum' Mission were very prayerful. The cookout and other festivities of Saturday Vigil went smoothly and joyfully. One of the greatest challenges we were trying to overcome this year was to make everybody, Anglos and Haitians, be effective parts of our celebrations. The feedback I've been getting makes me feel that we did it pretty well. This weekend's gospel reminds us of a sin that we commit so often, the so-called 'sin by omission,' when we fail to perform our duties. For we can sin in what we do, but we can also sin in what we do not do, what we fail to do, as we mention it when we recite the 'I confess' at mass. The rich man of the gospel ignored the distress of Lazarus, who was laid at his doorstep, very hungry and half-dead. He showed no concern, no compassion to one created like him in the image of God. Instead of using his wealth he was used by his wealth. At the end, he himself became the real beggar! There are so many 'Lazarus' in our cities, on our sidewalks and sometimes knocking at our doors. But we too are sometimes so busy, so preoccupied minding our own business that we do not care either. Children of the same God our Father and disciples of Christ, any suffering in the world shouldn't keep us indifferent! Someone had said that the true opposite of love is indifference. As we look for God and his Kingdom, let us remind ourselves that God is present in the very details of our daily lives when we show love and charity to everyone especially the needy. "Where there's Charity and Love, God is there!"

**Bien chers frères et sœurs,**

En ce 26<sup>ème</sup> dimanche du temps ordinaire de l'année liturgique C, il est encore question du riche dans l'évangile. Nous demandons-nous peut-être : est ce que Jésus avait un problème avec les riches?

Jésus n'a jamais condamné les riches. Néanmoins, il les a toujours prévenus du danger de l'orgueil et de la cupidité. C'est dire que la richesse est une véritable épreuve car il est difficile d'être riche tout en conservant un cœur de pauvre. En effet, pour Jésus, la fidélité au Royaume de Dieu se vit au cœur des événements quotidiens, au travers de la quête et de l'usage intelligent de l'argent. Puisque même considéré comme principal agent de liberté, d'autonomie et d'épanouissement, l'argent peut également avoir des effets aliénants pour celui qui en fait un mauvais usage.

En fin de compte, riche ou pauvre, on finira par paraître devant Dieu. A travers cette parabole, Jésus, loin de vouloir blâmer le riche, veut plutôt démontrer le caractère transitoire aussi bien de la richesse que de la pauvreté terrestre. La condition humaine recèle sans doute quelque chose de comparable à l'expérience du riche et du pauvre Lazare. Car, après des décennies de bonheur et d'opulence pour les uns, de misère et d'indigence pour les autres, il faudra finalement rendre compte à Celui à qui tout appartient. Il est donc temps de nous convertir et d'apprendre le juste usage des richesses, mais aussi des dons que chacun de nous a reçus de Dieu, en vue de construire un monde plus humain et plus fraternel.

Le mot ange vient du grec "angelos" et signifie "messenger." Le mot archange vient du grec "archangelos": arkhè qui veut dire "commandement" et ángelos " messenger". Donc un archange est un chef des anges. Les archanges connus par leurs noms sont : Saint Michel, un Archange dont le nom signifie « qui est comme Dieu ». Il est le prince de la milice céleste. Son nom est mentionné dans le livre de Daniel et dans l'Apocalypse. Michel est le chef de l'armée de Dieu pendant la révolte de Lucifer, il est celui qui a terrassé le dragon personnifiant le diable. Considéré comme l'intermédiaire entre Dieu et les hommes, il est depuis très longtemps vénéré dans toute la chrétienté puisque c'est lui qui est en charge de conduire au Paradis les âmes qui sont aptes à y être admises. Saint Michel est le patron des ambulanciers, des artistes, des banquiers, des navigateurs, des techniciens en radiologie, des épiciers, des officiers de police, des gardiens de sécurité etc. Il est invoqué pour lutter contre la tentation et pour faire cesser les tempêtes en mer. Saint Gabriel, un Archange dont le nom signifie « Dieu est force ». Il est le messenger spécial de Dieu. Il est apparu à trois reprises : au prophète Daniel, à Zacharie pour lui annoncer la naissance de son fils (Jean le Baptiste), et à Marie pour lui annoncer qu'elle deviendrait la mère du Sauveur. Saint Gabriel est le patron des professionnels de la télédiffusion et des communications. Saint Raphaël, un Archange, dont le nom signifie « Dieu guérit ». Il avait rendu la vue au père de Tobie et favorisé son mariage avec Sara. Saint Raphael est le patron des personnes aveugles et des malades en général, des médecins, des pharmaciens, des amoureux, des bergers, des voyageurs et des jeunes. Il est invoqué pour ne pas faire de cauchemars et pour la guérison des maladies des yeux.

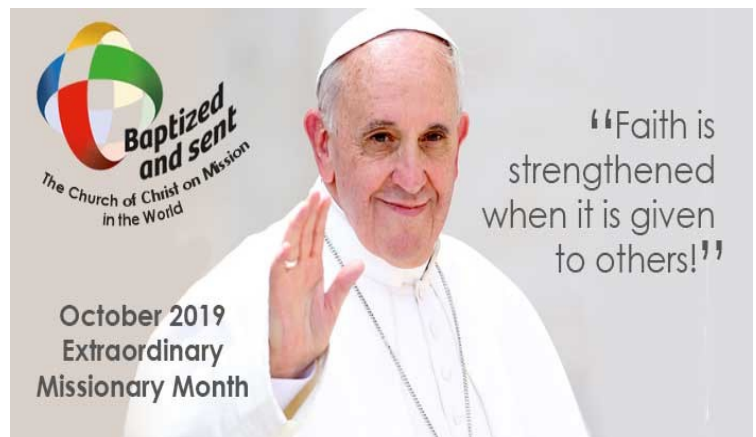

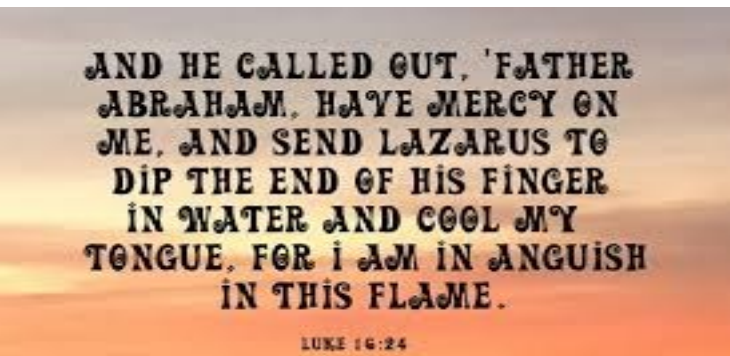
